<b>Job Title:</b>	Cabin Counselor
<b>Job Summary:</b>	The cabin counselor is responsible for ensuring the health and well-being of the campers in their cabin. Two Cabin Counselors are assigned to a cabin and work together as a team.
<b>Supervisor:</b>	Cabin Counselor Lead
<b>Qualifications:</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Must be at least 18 years of age by June 1</li><li>2. Must pass a federal background check</li><li>3. Current first aid/CPR certification</li><li>4. Experience with children preferred</li><li>5. Must be able to lift 50lbs.</li><li>6. Must be able to live in a cabin</li></ol>
<b>Responsibilities</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Live in cabins with 6-10 campers</li><li>2. Facilitate “cabin cleanup” and “rest time” each day</li><li>3. Ensure campers wake up, complete morning routines, and are at the morning activity on time</li><li>4. Ensure campers are maintaining appropriate hygiene (brushing teeth, showering, etc)</li><li>5. Facilitate bed-time routines and make sure campers are in their bunks by lights-out</li><li>6. Participate and provide oversight during camp activities</li><li>7. Communicate all pertinent issues affecting campers or the cabin to the supervisor in a timely manner</li><li>8. Establish good rapport with families during camper drop-off and pick-up.</li></ol>
<b>Compensation:</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Housing (cabin)</li><li>2. Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner on camp days</li><li>3. \$750</li></ol>
<b>Status</b>	Seasonal (July)
