Responsibilities:	<ol> <li>Oversee the set-up and closing of the Health Center.</li> <li>Take inventory of all supplies and equipment at the start and end of camp.</li> <li>Provide staff training on health/safety procedures during orientation.</li> <li>Set up and run a system of health screenings for arriving campers and staff.</li> <li>Be the point of contact with parents when receiving medication and dispensing instructions.</li> <li>Organize all camper medication and set up a "dispensing system".</li> <li>Administer medication and treatment to campers throughout their stay at camp</li> <li>Assess and assist with the health and hygiene needs of campers.</li> </ol>

	<ol> <li>Keep an accident/incident report</li> <li>Identify pertinent camper medical needs and communicate this information to appropriate camp staff and parents, as necessary.</li> <li>Administer first aid, perform nursing assessments, and implement nursing intervention as guided by nursing judgment.</li> <li>Keep records regarding administration of medication, prescribed treatments, and other health and medical needs (following state and ACA standards).</li> <li>Make rounds throughout the camp checking on campers, staff, and the health/safety of camp in general.</li> <li>Determining and ordering over-the-counter medications and PPE.</li> <li>Lead staff trainings pertaining to camp health and safety</li> <li>Report facility and grounds health risk factors.</li> <li>Complete and follow up on incident reports.</li> <li>At the conclusion of camp, prepare a summary and evaluation of the summer sessions including inventories, camper health problems, and make recommendations for the following year.</li> <li>Perform other duties as assigned.</li> </ol>
