Job Title:	Cabin Counselor
Job Summary:	The cabin counselor is responsible for ensuring the health and well-being of the campers in their cabin. Two Cabin Counselors are assigned to a cabin and work together as a team.
Supervisor:	Cabin Counselor Lead
Qualifications:	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Must be at least 18 years of age by June 1 2. Must pass a federal background check 3. Current first aid/CPR certification 4. Experience with children preferred 5. Must be able to lift 50lbs. 6. Must be able to live in a cabin
Responsibilities	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Live in cabins with 6-10 campers 2. Facilitate “cabin cleanup” and “rest time” each day 3. Ensure campers wake up, complete morning routines, and are at the morning activity on time 4. Ensure campers are maintaining appropriate hygiene (brushing teeth, showering, etc) 5. Facilitate bed-time routines and make sure campers are in their bunks by lights-out 6. Participate and provide oversight during camp activities 7. Communicate all pertinent issues affecting campers or the cabin to the supervisor in a timely manner 8. Establish good rapport with families during camper drop-off and pick-up.
Compensation:	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Housing (cabin) 2. Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner on camp days 3. \$60 a day
Status	Seasonal (July)
